1. This Invitation for Bids follows the General Procurement Notice for this Project that appeared in *UNDB*, issue on October 7, 2015.
2. The Ministry of Electricity (MoE) has received financing from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development toward the cost of the Emergency Operation for Development Project (EODP), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for **Supplying of Cables and Wires for Diyala & Salah Al-Din governorates in Iraq.**

The identification number of the lots comprising this ICB is: **EODP-MOE/D.E/G9**

The number and identification of lots (contracts) comprising this ICB is:

Lot1: Supplying wires for Salah Al-Din & Diyala

Lot2: Supplying L.V cables for Salah Al-Din & Diyala

Lot3: supplying Twisted cables for Diyala

3. The Ministry of Electricity (MoE) now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for **supplying of Cables and Wires for Diyala & Salah Al-Din**. The final destination for Diyala is : **Middle distribution warehouse / in Baghdad Governorate** , and the final destination for Salah AL-Din is: **North Distribution Warehouse in Kirkuk Governorate with the delivery period from 90 to 180 days.**
4. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures specified in the World Bank's *Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits* by WB Borrowers, and is open to all eligible bidders from Eligible Source Countries as defined in the Procurement Guidelines.
5. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from the Ministry of Electricity (MoE)/ Project Management Team/Email: eodp@moelc.gov.iq, and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during office hours **from 8:00 to 14:00 Baghdad Local Time.**
6. A complete set of Bidding Documents in **English** may be purchased by interested eligible bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of **500 USD**. The method of payment will be paid either in Cash or by certified check, and the Bidding Documents will be picked-up from the PMT office address shown below. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **11:00 a.m. Baghdad Local Time on Sep. 18, 2016**. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the bidders'

representatives and anyone who choose to attend at the address below at **11:30 a.m Baghdad Local Time on Sep. 18, 2016.**

7. The Bid validity must be 60 days from the closing date.
8. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Securities as follows:
US\$ 26500 for Lot1: Supplying wires for Salah al Din & Diyala
US\$ 30000 for Lot2: Supplying L.V cables for Salah al Din & Diyala
US\$ 8000 for Lot3: Supplying twisted cables for Diyala
9. The validity of the Bid Security shall be after **28 days** from the Bid Validity (**88 days after the closing date**).
10. Requests for clarification should be received by the Employer not later than **7 Calendar Days before the closing date**.
11. The prices shall be fixed and not depend on L.M.E. price.
12. The tenders without original bank guarantee will be rejected. (Tenders with swift will be rejected).
13. Sample of cable and wires is required, offers without samples will be rejected.
14. A pre bid meeting will be held on **Aug. 25, 2016 at 10:00 a.m Baghdad Local Time** in address below.
15. Tender prices should be in Dollar.
